

Sheila is okay with sharing Levi with Phoenix, but eventually starts to feel left out. Phoenix is tired of the restrictions that their relationship is placed under and decides she wants her own husband.

Emotional Abuse Signs

The purpose of this film is to bring awareness to Narcissistic & Emotional Abuse, which is a form of domestic violence that rarely gets addressed. Emotional abuse can leave deep internal scars and can be just as traumatic, if not worse, than physical abuse. Furthermore, the long term and psychological damage can be irreversible.



Some examples of Emotional Abuse are:

- 1. THE SILENT TREATMENT
- 2. Abusers regularly points out your flaws, mistakes, or shortcomings.
- 3. Abusers make excuses for their behavior, blame others, and have difficulty apologizing.
- 4. Abusers make you feel as if you're walking on eggshells; scared to say or do something that they "disapprove" of.
- 5. Abusers consistently make you doubt yourself.
- 6. Abusers accuse you of being "too sensitive" in order to deflect their abusive remarks.

These words/actions can eventually chip away at the self-esteem and self-worth of victims. Oddly enough with abusive relationships, some victims still find it difficult to leave. The abuser may have their "nice" days, which can leave the victim frequently confused. This short-lived charm is most likely the thread that holds the relationship together. Also, the victim may have been manipulated into thinking that they're nothing without the abuser, keeping the victim hostage to their abuse. More often, victims will stay and endure the abuse while slowly fading away.



What Is Traumatic Bonding?

Traumatic bonding, also called Stockholm Syndrome, occurs in abusive relationships which are characterized by an imbalance of power, high intensity, and an unpredictable atmosphere, rapidly shifting between periods of cruelty and tenderness.

Traumatic bonds can form very quickly and last long after the relationship is severed.


Statistics

There are an estimated 326 million people in the U.S. **One in 25 people will have the disorders associated with 'no conscience'** which include anti-social personality disorder, narcissistic personality disorder, sociopath, and psychopath. 326 million divided by 25 = **13.04 million people with no conscience!** Each person with either disorder will have approximately five partners who will be negatively affected by their pathology = 60.8 million people.
